Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing just 4 individuals. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Within 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to forty workers and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Nowadays, Cascade is amongst the top global manufacturers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the last 60 years, the industry of material handling has grown into a really sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its development. Cascade currently continues to develop as the leader supplier of lift truck attachments and different related products. The business feels confident in their skill in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, fabricating and promoting hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was done in 1956 on a brand new office in order to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its manufacturing plants within the United States with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are made internationally because of a lot of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is made to be the essential customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of 5 corporations, along with the international best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
